

Sorry Mr. President, You're Wrong

We are always impressed by your eloquent speech. As you once told Harry Reid, "I have a gift", and that is the ability to change people's minds by using this gift of "Golden Tongue". As with any gift from God, it is the use of it that tells the true measure of a person.

We along with most Americans agree with some of what you covered and we were saddened that you resorted to your strongly partisan nature in many parts of your speech.

You said "If you misrepresent what is in the bill, we will call you out". So, Mr. President, we in turn will call you out.

You said those that claimed the bill HR3200 would cover illegal aliens were "LIARS". In fact it does and we lay it out for you here.

In Section 152 **PROHIBITING DISCRIMINATION IN HEALTH CARE.**

22 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as otherwise explicitly permitted by this Act and by subsequent regulations consistent with this Act, all health care and related services (including insurance coverage and public health activities) covered by this Act shall be provided without regard to personal characteristics extraneous to the provision of high quality health care or related services.

As you can see the term "personal characteristics" is all encompassing. A personal characteristic can be legal citizen or illegal alien.

The bill was very cleverly written and to the novice would appear not to cover illegal aliens because in Section 246 of [the bill](#) it does indeed contain language to the effect that illegal immigrants will not receive "Federal payments for affordability credits":

"Nothing in this subtitle shall allow Federal payments for affordability credits on behalf of individuals who are not lawfully present in the United States."

Cleverly it refers only to "this subtitle" and not the entire bill. This is only one loophole. It will force Hospitals to cover them with "Charity dollars" which will no longer be needed for the uninsured (everyone is required to have health insurance). Nothing will need to be allocated because of the money available through other means. How very clever. This is only one loophole that allows illegal aliens to be covered. There is no verification process in the bill for legality. (how convenient)

This bill was not written in a few weeks or months. It has been written over years with an incredible amount of effort put in to dupe the American Public. Just because the bill does not state it will not do something does not mean that it will not do that something. It depends on what the definition of the word "is" is.

HR3200 is so cleverly written with so many twists and turns that the truth apparently has eluded even you, your staff and thirty six Czars.

You also said those who said the bill creates "Death Panels" were "LIARS". This would be true if in fact this is what they said. Again, the bill does not specifically say "Death Panels". In fact the process of limiting care and medications was started in the "Stimulus Bill" where \$1.1 billion was allocated for "Comparative Effectiveness Research". This process is used in Canada, The U.K., Germany, Australia, etc. for the purpose of limiting care to the elderly because it is not cost effective.

President Obama has proposed a new body that would enhance Medicare's ability to deny care to the elderly and disabled based on government bureaucrats' arbitrary valuations of those patients' lives. Obama's first pick to head his health reform efforts—former Senate

Majority Tom Daschle—proposed an IMAC-like panel despite the fact that “doctors and patients might resent” the panel making decisions about “matters of life and death.” Back in June, in response to a question about “subjective” end-of-life decisions, President Obama said, “I think we have to have rules.” And who would make those rules? His IMAC proposal tells us. This type of government rationing already happens in the United Kingdom. Britain’s National Institute for Health and Clinical Excellence (or “NICE”) generally refuses to cover medical treatments that cost <http://content.nejm.org/cgi/reprint/359/19/1977.pdf>>more than \$35,000 per year of life saved. **Sarah Palin is right.** Whatever one thinks of Sarah Palin should not distract from this truth: President Obama proposes to let government bureaucrats decide who gets medical care and who does not.

Call it what you want Mr. President, but this in conjunction with the very clever HR3200 results in a panel deciding the care for everyone. We could call it the "Comparative Effectiveness Panel". We could call it the "Cost Effectiveness Panel". We can call it IMAC or anything you want, the end result is the same. Your staff can "Google" this and find a significant amount of articles about it.

You said again, "If you like your insurance you can keep it". Again the cleverness of the bill has eluded you. When the bill is looked at in total it creates obstacles and conditions that will force everyone into a government run plan within five years. You can find the analysis in numerous places on "Google" Your staff should learn to use this new media. This ultimate outcome is in line with your previous speeches (available on “YouTube” and Fox News) where you clearly state that it may take five, ten or fifteen years to move everyone to the single payer system you want.

You said again, "If you like your doctor you can keep them". This is only a three to five year promise. Again this statement is betrayed by the cleverness of the bill.
